

The church of My Ego & the Meaning of Life, part 2

The meaning of life, which you find wherever you may look, is not to heap flattery on God, as many ancient religions want us to believe, but to further the process of evolution: to evolve continuously towards higher forms of life, that is to say, to care, to improve and to find a higher level of order in science, in society, in education, in your home, in your soul and last but not least in your ego.

Your ego is at its most stable if it is in line with the meaning of life [the will and ego of God, the self, the universe]. Only if the ego is stable [like a ball which rests at the vertex after being tossed into a bowl], your mind, feelings, choices, endeavors, plans, works and lifestyle can inspire the universe in favor of yourself.

The more your ego rests exclusively in the zeitgeist or in any tradition or in any modernism or in any denomination or in any political ideology ... or in any form of atheism, the less it is interconnected with the self [the will and the ego of God: with the destiny of the universe] and the smaller your spiritual consciousness, your integrality, your real success.

Jesus also interacted with the cosmos: he encountered the meaning of life fully when he participated in what we call evolution, found and thought out an essential order, namely: the modality in which you shall evolve continuously towards higher forms of life, in which you shall care, improve and higher and higher levels of order in science, in society, in education, in your home, in your soul and last but not least in your ego integrally, this modus is Love.
